THE SAFE, LEGAL AND PROPER OPERATION OF CARRIER SUPERSEDES ANY REQUEST, DEMAND, PREFERENCE, INSTRUCTION OR INFORMATION PROVIDED BY TQL OR ITS CUSTOMERS WITH RESPECT TO ANY SHIPMENT. IF ANY EMPLOYEE OF TQL OR ITS CUSTOMER REQUESTS, DEMANDS, OR INSTRUCTS CARRIER TO TAKE ANY ACTION THAT VIOLATES ANY LAW, CARRIER SHALL REFUSE TO TRANSPORT THE LOAD AND IMMEDIATELY CONTACT TQL BEFORE TAKING ANY FURTHER ACTION. CARRIER AGREES THAT WHEN IT CHOOSES TO TRANSPORT A LOAD IT DOES SO ON ITS OWN VOLITION, EXERCISING ITS OWN DISCRETION WITHOUT COERCION OR UNDUE INFLUENCE BY ANY INDIVIDUAL OR ENTITY. BY SIGNING THIS RATE CONFIRMATION AND/OR PERFORMING SERVICES FOR BROKER, CARRIER AFFIRMS THAT IT MAINTAINS KNOWLEDGE OF AND COMPLIANCE WITH ALL FEDERAL, STATE, AND LOCAL LAWS AND REGULATIONS, WHICH INCLUDES, BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO, ANY LAWS OR REGULATIONS RELATED TO CARB COMPLIANCE, THE CALIFORNIA TRANSPORT REFRIGERATION UNIT (TRU) OR AIRBORNE TOXIC CONTROL MEASURE (ATCM). CARRIER AFFIRMS THAT ALL OF ITS APPLICABLE EQUIPMENT TRAVELLING TO, FROM, OR WITHIN CALIFORNIA IS IN COMPLIANCE WITH CARB RULES AND REGULATIONS OR ANY OTHER SIMILAR REGULATIONS IN OTHER STATES WHEN TRAVELLING TO, FROM, OR WITHIN SUCH OTHER STATES. Please read and adhere to the following requirements.

By signing this rate confirmation, you fully understand and agree to requirements.

For All Shipments:

- Driver must accept and maintain TQL's Carrier Dashboard/Macropoint/Project44 Tracking for the duration of the shipment.
- Exclusive use of the trailer is required, and the load cannot be run as a partial
- Loads cannot go to the driver(s) home or be left unattended
- Driver(s) must arrive at the shipper with a full tank of fuel, well rested, and fresh on hours
- Driver(s) must drive 250 miles after picking up
- Drivers are required to provide a valid driver's license when checking in for loading/offloading, failure to do so will result in rejection/loss of the load without compensation
- IF DUNNAGE OR OUTRIGGERS REQUIRED
- Dunnage must be Oak wood, minimum 10" W and 12" H.
- Outriggers must support full weight of the units loaded
- Carrier must provide communication to TQL:
- Upon or immediately before arrival to appointments, or ETA within a FCFS window
- Checking into the facility
- After loading has been completed
- After unloading has been completed
- Loads sold "per mile" or "per drop" may be reduced to the applicable miles and drops should the shipper remove a stop after dispatch.
- Permits are purchased on behalf of the carrier. Fallout can be subject to fees associated with purchase.
- If incorrect information is provided by the carrier for the purchase, the carrier will be responsible for any additional permit purchases on their behalf.

Detention/Layover Requirements (For All Picks and Drops):

- Tracking must be accepted and maintained for the duration of the load. No detention/layover will be approved for un-tracked loads.
- Carrier must be checked in/on time for their appointment. If given an appointment, FCFS, or arrival window, the driver must arrive within the given window.
- Carrier must notify TQL 30 minutes prior to free period ending and detention beginning by call, text, or email.
- ALL detention, layover, or TONU requests must be submitted to teamberlundops@tql.com within 24 hours of delivery
- All pages of the BOL/POD must be submitted to be reviewed for detention.
- BOL/POD must have printed, stamped, or handwritten check in and check out times.
- Handwritten times should be signed by the facility as well as matching TQLs tracking to be accepted.
- Detention does not apply when layover is in effect.
- Detention does not apply on loads that are "self-loading/unloading"

Detention Payment Schedule:

- Flatbed/Step Deck/ Hotshot
- Detention: \$30 per hour - 3 hours free. **Capped at \$200 per weekday.**
- TONU: \$150 + Permits if applicable and receipts must be provided
- Layover: **\$200 per weekday**
- RGN
- Detention: \$60 per hour - 3 hours free. **Capped at \$300 per weekday.**
- TONU: \$250 + Permits if applicable and receipts must be provided
- Layover: **\$300 per weekday**

No TONU will be paid unless load is canceled at or after scheduled loading appointment; CARRIER MUST BE ONSITE AT TIME OF CANCELLATION; carriers late to scheduled pick up appointment are not eligible for TONU regardless of cancellation time


